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The following is our recommendation for adult equine vaccination:

SPRING

Two visits 2-4 weeks apart beginning Feb-April

Visit 1:

E/W Encephalomyelitis*
Tetanus Toxoid*
West Nile Virus vaccine**
Rabies*
Botulism **

Visit 2:

Potomac Horse Fever (PHF) **
Rhino EHV 1/4 ***+
Flu Intranasal***

FALL

One visit between August and October

Potomac Horse Fever (PHF) **
Rhino EHV 1/4 ***+
Flu Intranasal***

YEARLY *(Spring or fall)*

Strangles***
Coggins test for Equine Infectious Anemia++

**Strongly Recommended*

***Recommended*

****Recommended depending on stabling and exposure expectations*

+ Recommended once every 12 weeks (once every 3 months) for those horses with a high risk exposure, e.g. on a heavy show schedule. You may need USEF certificate of vaccination for showing, check with your venue.

++ NJ State requires a coggins test once every 24 months for travel on any state road. However, boarding facilities, show organizations, and any interstate travel usually require a negative coggins within the past 12 months, and in some instances even sooner. A legal prepurchase exam requires a negative coggins within 90 days of the sale.
