The following is our recommendation for deworming adult horses:

If using Strongid C as a daily dewormer – use Ivermectin (or moxidectin) + Praziquantel in spring and fall to control bots.

Proper dosing according to body weight is important in order for your deworming to be safe and efficacious. If you are unsure, please ask one of our veterinarians for help in determining your horse's body weight. Also remember that regular clean up of manure both in stalls and pasture is important in the management of equine parasites.

Quest and Quest plus are recommended only for horses greater than 1 year of age and are not recommended in miniature horses, ponies or donkeys.

3 months	Pyrantel
4 months	Ivermectin
6 months	Pyrantel
8 months	Ivermectin + Praziquantel
10 months	Pyrantel
12 months	Moxidectin
