The following is our recommendation for vaccination of pregnant mares:

Equine Rhinopneumonitis vaccine (Pneumabort-K for EHV-1) at **3*, 5, 7, and 9** months of pregnancy

Pre-foaling booster vaccinations

3 months prior to due date:

Botulism #1 - only if mare is unvaccinated for botulism

2 months prior to due date:

Pneumabort K
Influenza
Potomac Horse Fever
Botulism #2 – Only if series started the month before

1 month prior to due date:

E/W Encephalomyelitis
Tetanus
West Nile
Rabies
Botulism Booster or #3 - If doing series

- * **This use is off label at this time – please consult one of our veterinarians.**
- **Note: It is important that mares be current in the above pre-foaling vaccines PRIOR to breeding. If your mare is NOT current in one of these vaccines and is already pregnant, please contact one of our veterinarians for advice.**
- **Please remind us to check for a caslicks when we are giving pre-foaling shots.**
